

## Success Factors

- Use committees, advisers, and outside expertise
- Keep members informed
- Conduct businesslike meetings
- Maintain good board-management relations
- Follow sound accounting practices
  - Develop alliances with other cooperatives.
- Develop clear policies

# Potential risks to a new co-op include:

- Lack of a clearly defined mission, purpose and focus
- Lack of member leadership
- Inadequate feasibility study and/or business plan
- Failure to use experienced advisors and consultants
- Lack of financial commitment from members
- Lack of competent management to run the coop's operations
- Failure to identify and minimize business risks
- Lack of adequate financing
- Inadequate communications
